

Renowned pianist **Tony Gould** and cellist **Imogen Manins** are coming up from Melbourne to join forces with Sydney-based Zen master and flautist **Riley Lee** for another musical adventure following on from their successful collaboration at the Melbourne Recital Hall in 2013. Come prepared to be hypnotised and for your breath to be taken away.

Riley Lee and our international guest guitarist Jeff Peterson will also feature in duet format. Jeff Peterson is a slack key guitar player from Maui, Hawaii. The son of a paniolo (Hawaiian cowboy) at Haleakala Ranch, Jeff was exposed to the sounds of slack key at an early age. Jeff's style fuses traditional Slack Key with elements of classical and jazz guitar. Jeff has contributed to many albums, including a series of slack key and bamboo flute duets with Riley Lee, several slack key compilations including the Grammy Winning album "Slack Key Guitar Volume 2", "Slack Key Guitar: The Artistry of Jeff Peterson", as well as his most recent solo album "Maui On My Mind".

James Greening launched his band 'Greening from Ear to Ear' at our 2012 January Kinetic Jazz Festival. Check out their musical greening now as they kick off on the first day. James Greening - trombone/ sousaphone / pocket trumpet, Gary Daley - accordion, piano, Brett Hirst - Double Bass, Hamish Stuart - drums, Fabian Hevia - percussion, Andrew Robson - alto & soprano sax, Paul Cutlan - bass clarinet, tenor sax.

The Female Voice is featured by two extraordinary vocalists: Singer songwriter **Tanya Sparke**, who returns with a fresh book, accompanied by vocalists **Jacqueline Amidy**, **Ben Fink**, **Trish Watts**, pianist **Peter Dasent** and bass player **Zoe Hauptmann**. And also by singer composer **Natalie Dietz** whose rising star comes to adorn our festival for the first time. Natalie will be joined by **Hugh Barrett** - piano, **Tom Botting** - bass, **Nic Cecire** - drums, **Carl Morgan** - guitar

Another first for us is that 'weaver of dreams', **Andrew Dickeson** with his quintet **Burn**. **Andrew Dickeson** - drums, **John Harkins** - piano, **Cam McAllister** - trumpet, **Michael Griffin** - saxophone, **Ashley Turner** - bass.

The musical minds of **Sandy Evans, Phil Slater, Simon Barker** & **Roger Dean** will dare you to walk out with them toward the unknown region of **SED**ition **B**.

Some members of our flagship - the Kinetic Jazz Orchestra - will contribute their own gig:

- Ben Hauptmann pays tribute to Wes Montgomery with Bill Risby, James Hauptmann and Jonathan Zwartz
- Don Reid, Bruce Cale, Alex Masso and guest Guy Strazullo come together in a new quartet.
- **Bill Risby, Dave Ellis** and **Alex Masso** combine with our international guest from the USA, guitarist **Jeff Peterson**
- and Tim Clarkson's trio will play a selection of pieces from their latest album "Land of Free Men".

Microtonal masters **Kraig Grady** & **Terumi Narushima** (creators of mental-ambient **Clocks and Clouds**) invite you to lie back (literally, on our special Noise Exposure beanbags) and immerse yourself in their sonographical installation of Anaphoric sounds and shapes. Why not allow yourself to be exposed to the subconscious, psychoactive power of this surreal music!

Every night (except Sunday) Kinetic Energy Theatre Company, led by **Graham Jones** & **Jepke Goudsmit**, will treat you to a rendition of that famously tongue-in-cheek Jive Talk piece by Lord Buckley: The Nazz. Graham & Jepke will also perform their mesmerising candle dance "Sweet & Lovely", an eccentric love story on wheels, danced to the music of that name in an arrangement by Thelonious Monk. And our Kinetic Cinema will show footage both from the archives and new, curated by Saha Jones.

The Festival finishes with the big sound, the contagious joy and the exquisite lyricism of our very own **Kinetic Jazz Orchestra**. They will perform three new works, one by **Don Reid** to feature special guest **Riley Lee**, another from associate composer **Roger Dean** and one from the prolific pen of **Mike Kenny**.

We are very fortunate to have the magnificent **Stuart Piano** again for our pianists, courtesy of the ongoing support by Alberts Music and Stuart & Sons.

The **Kinetic Café**, where Lucy Martin's scepter sways, will be open for delicious food & drinks from 7pm each night (Sunday from 4.30).

We feel privileged to be able to present you with such a beautiful program, and are lucky indeed that all our contributors are not somewhere overseas but happen to be in Sydney at this time!
